Cell Phone Policy

Preamble

Koinonia Christian School-Red Deer understands that cell phones are used extensively in our society. The use of this technology by students at KCS-Red Dee during school hours creates a challenge in the school environment. In order to address this challenge the following Cell Phone Policy has been developed and approved by the Board.

Policy

Cell phones are not to be carried on their person but may be stored in your locker, your car or in the school office during school hours. They must be turned during school hours. School hours are as follows:

Monday-Friday from 8:30-3:30 pm

Students who need to use a phone during the school may use the designated student phone by the office and follow the procedure already existing.

Consequences

Consequences for violating this policy are as follows:

1st offence: Cell phone confiscated from student. Parents of the student are contacted. The cell phone is returned to the parents of the student and KCS-RD cell phone policy will be explained to the student and the parents.

2nd offence: Cell phone confiscated. Parents of the student are contacted. The phone is returned to the parent of the student and the student is no longer allowed to have a cell phone on school property, during school hours, for the remainder of the school year.

3rd Offence: Cell phone confiscated. Parents of the student are contacted. The student will receive a 3-day suspension from school. A re-admission meeting involving the student, parents of the student and school administrator will be required. In that re-admission meeting the condition of re-enrolment will be communicated to the student and parents of the student.
